

Project Lifesaver

Project Lifesaver was established in April of 1999 as an initiative of the 43rd Virginia Search and Rescue Company of the Chesapeake Sheriff's Office. Project Lifesaver's mission is to use technology in assisting those who care for victims of Alzheimer's and Related Mental Dysfunction Disorders (ARMD) and victims who become lost. Project Lifesaver places personalized radio transmitters on identified persons with ARMD. These transmitters assist care givers and local emergency agencies in locating those who cannot help themselves.

Project Lifesavers Status

As of January 2013 there have been over 2638 lives saved and credited to Project Lifesaver with an average locating time of 30 minutes. Project Lifesaver programs are growing across the country. The program is currently in 47 states, Canada, and Australia. Most, if not all localities in the Hampton Roads area now have this program in place.

The Project Lifesaver Program is offered 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Funding for Project Lifesaver is a result of private and corporate donations and grants.
