Welcome to Veterans Park

Veterans Park is home to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial monument donated by local resident David Hooker in 1993 to honor residents who gave their lives in the Vietnam War.

The 19-acre park is also home to Kidsburg, a 30,000 square-foot lighted playground that features separate play areas for children ages 2-5 and 5-12, a ship replica, swing areas and a zip line.

Other park amenities include a 0.6-mile paved ADA accessible multiuse trail, sand volleyball courts, lighted basketball courts and tennis/pickleball courts, Wi-Fi connectivity and lots of open space. Picnic shelters and meeting room space are available to rent.

Rentable Amenities

- Meeting room
- Picnic shelters

From Richmond: Take I-64 East towards Williamsburg. Take the VA-199 exit, Exit 234, towards VA-646/Lightfoot merge onto VA-199 East. In 6 miles, take the VA-321 West/Monticello Avenue exit. Fork right on the exit ramp and go .3 mi to the third stoplight. Turn left on to News Road. At the top of the hill, turn right at the light on to Ironbound Road. Take the first right into Veterans Park.

Rental Guidelines

- The meeting room accommodates up to 24 people with tables and chairs, and may be reserved between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. After-hour reservations will incur additional staff charges.
- Picnic shelters accommodate up to 50 people and each shelter has five picnic tables and a charcoal grill—only the playground shelter has electricity. Picnic shelters are available for rent March–October between 9 a.m.–8 p.m. Between November and February, picnic shelters are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Picnic shelters may be reserved in-person or online. To reserve a picnic shelter in-person or to reserve the meeting room or court space, visit the James City County Recreation Center, 5301 Longhill Road during operating hours.
- Approval of court rental is based on event size and previously scheduled park reservations.
- Reservations are welcome 12 months in advance and payment is due at the time of rental.

From Norfolk: Take I-64 East towards Williamsburg. Take the VA-199 exit, Exit 242A to merge onto VA-199 West toward Williamsburg/Jamestown. In 6.9 miles, take the VA-321 West/Monticello Avenue exit. Stay to the left of the fork towards the stoplight at the bottom of the ramp. Go .3 mi to the third stoplight and turn left on to News Road. At the top of the hill turn right at the light on to Ironbound Road. Take the first right into Veterans Park.

Park Regulations

To provide a safe, enjoyable and clean environment for visitors, please observe the following:

- Children under age 12 must be supervised by a guardian age 16 or older.
- Pets must be at all times with the owner on an eight feet or shorter leash.
- Animals, except Service Animals as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, are prohibited on courts or playgrounds or other designated facilities.
- Smoking and E-cigarettes are not permitted within 25 feet of courts, playgrounds or other facilities.
- Unmanned aircraft and kites are permitted only in designated areas.
- Fryers, smokers or towable grills require a Park Use Permit. Charcoal is permitted in park grills.
- Portable shade structures up to 16'x 16', with prior approval, are permitted only in designated areas.
- Prohibited: alcohol, archery, hitting golf balls, sidewalk chalk, music or noise (audible at 50 feet), driving to a picnic shelter to load/unload and overnight parking.
