Welcome to Little Creek Reservoir Park

Little Creek Reservoir Park is a fishing paradise! The fishing population includes yellow perch, black crappie, largemouth bass, blue catfish, bluegill, channel catfish, walleye, striped bass, bowfin, redbreast and chain pickerel. The 996-acre reservoir includes 40 miles of shoreline with depths up to 60 feet. Electric trolling motors are the only type of motors allowed on the reservoir.

The fishing is great! The Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries recognized one Little Creek Reservoir Park patron as the 2015 Angler of the Year. The striped bass, 32 pounds and 42 inches, caught in the reservoir was the largest officially registered striped bass with the Virginia Angler Recognition Program for 2015.

Park Rules

To assist patrons and staff in providing a safe, enjoyable and clean environment for all visitors, park rules and regulations are posted in the park and are available at jamescitycountyva.gov/recreation under "Parks and Trails." Of special note:

- All boats must be off the water 30 minutes before sunset
- Trolling motors only (non-gas powered)
- No swimming, wading or stand-up paddleboarding
- No alcohol allowed in park
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than eight (8) feet in length and under the owner's complete control. Owners are responsible for the removal of pet waste.

From Norfolk: Take I-64 West to exit 231A. Follow US 60W to Forge Road and make a left onto Lakeview Drive.



About Little Creek Reservoir Park

- The park is located in upper James City County, midway between Richmond and Newport News via Interstate 64.
- The reservoir is owned by the City of Newport News. It is a major water storage facility for the Peninsula.
- Recreation activities are regulated by James City County.
