

OFF-LEASH AREA RULES & REGULATIONS

Each park has posted rules and regulations to assist patrons and staff in providing a safe, enjoyable and clean environment for all park users. Please refer to James City County Parks & Recreation Public Facilities Rules and Regulations, and other park signage, for additional rules and regulations not listed below.

Dog Handlers:

- Are legally responsible for the actions of their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by them.
- May only allow their dog to run free while in the off-leash area. A leash is required in other areas of the park.
- Must clean up after their dog and properly dispose of waste.
- Shall be within sight and voice control of their dog at all times.
- Must not leave their dog unattended.
- Are limited to bringing no more than two dogs per visit.
- Are not permitted to professionally train dogs onsite.

Dogs:

- Must have a current dog license and be up-to-date on all vaccinations.
- Are not allowed off-leash if they are in heat, vicious or aggressive.
- Shall not be allowed to dig holes or harass other dogs, people or wildlife.
- Must be under immediate control of a handler age 16 or older.

General:

- Users of the off-leash area do so at their own risk.
- Use of the area by animals other than dogs is prohibited.
