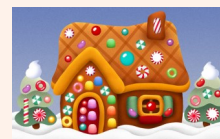
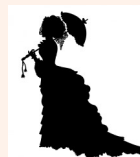

## LOUNGE TRIP REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

### Registration:

Lounge Trips are designed and planned to meet the interests & desires of Lounge members and citizens aged 55 or better.

An activity waiver form must be completed and on file to register for any trip. These forms are kept on file at the Front Desk.

The waiver forms are valid for one year from the date completed.

A couple can be listed on the same waiver form.

Registering and paying for a guest is allowed as long as the guest also has a completed waiver form on file.

Vans are boarded based on accessibility needs, and then first registered, first boarded. Any accessibility needs **must be noted at time of registration in order to be met**. Vans are always used unless noted on specific trip information.

Please note: Trip are designed for independent individuals. Staff and volunteers are NOT considered caregivers or aids. More information can be provided, call 757-259-4178.

### Payment:

Options for payments include:

In person, payment accepted by cash, check or credit card.

Over the phone, payment accepted by credit card only.

A convenience fee of 2.95% is applied to all credit and debit card purchases made to any James City County Department. To avoid the fee, please pay by check or cash.

Payment receipts can be printed and/or emailed. Receipts are needed to process any refunds.

Over the phone credit card payments can only be taken IF you have a current waiver form on file.

### Cancellations and Refunds:

If the trip is canceled by the Recreation Program Coordinator, all registered participants will receive a full refund of trip cost. The convenience fee for credit and debit purchases is non-refundable.

To receive a refund for canceling on your own, requests must be submitted and approved at least **seven (7)** days in advance of the trip date, unless otherwise noted on trip flyer. A 10% processing fee will be applied. Refunds can take up to four weeks to process.

Refunds requests can be obtained from the Front Desk staff or the Recreation Program Coordinator.

Refund can be issued if the rescheduled date for a trip previously canceled cannot be attended, participant will receive a full refund of trip cost.

### Transfers:

**Transferring "tickets" is not allowed. Payment and enrollment is unique to individual households and are NOT transferable to others. For refunds, see policy above.**

**Note:** Trip times are approximate and can be affected by numerous factors including traffic, weather and participants.

## ACTIVITY LEVELS FOR LOUNGE TRIPS

**Minimum** = Some walking and stairs with chances to sit (Ex= Dinner theater)

**Moderate** = Fair amount of walking and stairs, some chances to sit (Ex=Museums)

**Moderate-High** = Walking and stair climbing with little sitting (Ex= Boat/historical tours)

**High** = Lots of walking and climbing stairs for long periods of time (Ex=Battlefield/garden tours)
